# **'CULTURE OF INCLUSION'**

Inclusion at Blackall State School means removing barriers for staff, students, parents and the wider community, while working collaboratively to ensure that every student is succeeding whilst feeling calm, safe, supported and valued.

Thank you to our school community for your support throughout the year. 2021 has been a very rewarding and successful year for our students and our school.

Our student's and teacher's have worked hard to ensure that all of our students are succeeding every day in all curriculum areas. This year our A-E data for English has improved from 72% to 75% of students achieving a C or better. Maths has increased from 70% to 79%, and science has increased from 75 to 89 % C or better.

Staff morale has increased from 29.4% on our school opinion survey in July 2019 to 92.31% for the same survey in 2021. 80% of our students now believe that behaviour is well managed in our school compared to 42% in 2019.

## Empowering curiosity through an inclusive, respectful and literature rich environment

For 2022 our school will continue the improvement agenda of a 'Culture of Inclusion' and will also develop and implement a whole school approach and framework to teaching reading.
