\$114,400

This funding will be used to

- Improve student reading comprehension across all year levels;
- Develop consistent practices across year levels using the teaching strategies associated with the Literacy Continuum;
- Implement Positive Behaviour for Learning processes leading to a decrease in minor student behaviour issues and increase learning time;
- Support staff to increase the number of students in Upper 2 Bands (U2B) National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN);
- Purchase resources for classroom use to support key aspects of literacy.

Our initiatives include

- Strengthening the focus on Early Years outcomes;
- Focussing on improving reading comprehension across the school;
- Strengthening academic rigour of literacy rotations to ensure classroom practices enable students to achieve best possible outcomes.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Wages – classroom support	\$ 70,000
• Teaching Resources	\$ 21,000
• Wages – Speech Pathologist	\$ 18,000
• Positive Behaviour for Learning Resources	\$ 5,400
